Can your Parish use \$20,000?

Do you have links with one or more of the schools in your area?

CUT OFF DATE: 31st March 2007

HOW IT WORKS

- The school applies for funding of Chaplaincy services.
- All schools can apply.
- Funding of up to \$20,000 per year is available for each school.
- Funding is available for 3 years commencing July 2007.
- Closing date for applications is 31st March, 2007
- Second round of applications will be held in second half of 2007.
- 2 days per week will attract maximum funding of \$20,000.
- Schools can share Chaplaincy services.
- Chaplains can share service provision in a school.
- On line applications by the school.

WHAT TO DO: Negotiate with the school principal and the school community about the provision of services. The decision to apply for funding is with the school. Determine with the Parish how much time could be allocated to the provision of Chaplaincy services. Obtain the full guidelines.
